

## SUPPLY LIST FOR KLISE SISTERS' MASTER CLASS

**All you really need is paper, pen or pencil, and a computer connected to the internet. But if you want to take your art game to the next level, here's a list of Sarah's favorite art supplies.**

- **NOTEBOOK**

I like to start with a notebook measuring approximately 8" x 10". A partially used school notebook with lined paper is fine. You'll need about 40 blank pages in this notebook to create your rough draft.

- **PAPER**

I like to make my final books on cardstock paper because it's nice and thick. (Notebook paper and computer paper are a little too flimsy. Your pen might bleed through the page.) See if you have some heavier white paper in your cupboard. If not, cardstock from your local office supply store will work. Or, you could order this paper for \$5: <https://www.dickblick.com/items/10314-1043/>

- **PENS**

2 fine-point Sharpie pens (black)

- **MARKERS**

You'll want to collect all your markers and see what you have. Test them for juiciness. Organize them by color and width. We'll be working on cardstock paper, so we'll have to watch for marker bleed. Test your markers and see which will work best with your paper. - **COLORED PENCILS**

These will be important as we add color to our illustrations. Have enough colored pencils on hand and make sure they are sharpened. I love prismacolor because they last forever. - **MISCELLANEOUS**

Please make sure to have a pencil, eraser, sharpener, ruler, white-out, and post-its. You will also need a stapler/washi tape or a hole punch/ribbon to put everything together at the end.
